MINISTRY: HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH

- Adult Volunteers are positive Christian role models for the students in the group as well as provide supervision for youth events.

REPORTS TO:

- HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH PASTOR

COMMITMENT:

- Weekly Time Investment 3+ hours

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Accept or decline your role for the week on Planning Center Services
- Arrives at position 30 minutes prior to service or event start time
- Attend weekly pre-service Adult Volunteer meeting,
- Wears printed Name label while serving
- Greets all students as they arrive
- Partner with the leader running Check-In to welcome first-time students and introduce them to other students.
- Help lead a small group with a number of other Adult Volunteers getting students involved and answering the questions provided.
- When scheduled for Games, be in the gym at 9:00 pm (leave your small group early if needed) and lead the game as needed. As well as supervising the students in (and around) the gym.
- When scheduled for Hub, be upstairs when your small group is finished, making sure someone is selling drinks, candy, chocolate. As well as supervising the students in the room.
- Departs from position after 10:00 pm making sure you're not leaving another Adult Volunteer alone with students in the room.
- Recruits other Adult Volunteers to serve in Youth Ministry

CORE COMPETENCIES:

- Discipleship: Knows the gospel and takes responsibility for connecting with students so that no one is left out.
- Vision & Strategy: Not babysitters, but mentors during and after youth.
- Collaboration: Serves humbly.
- People Development: Displays willingness to be developed, as well as to develop others.
- Stewardship: Uses the gifts God has given them
